Sandra Fox opened the meeting by stating the instructions for submitting bids. All Bids must be received in the Office of the Maryland Stadium Authority located at 333 West Camden Street, Suite 500, Baltimore, Maryland 21201, **no later than 11:00 a.m. on October 30, 2017**. Late, faxed, or emailed bids will not be accepted. A minimum overall MBE subcontract participation goal of twenty percent (20%) of the total dollar value of the Contract is established for this procurement. Only bidders who are registered with the Maryland Department of General Services Small Business Reserve Program are eligible for award of this contract. Prospective bidders were urged to check the website for future addenda. It is the Bidders' responsibility to make sure they have received all appropriate documents, prior to the bid due date. All Bidders must be registered with eMaryland Marketplace in order to receive a contract award. The term of the contract shall be for two (2) years with a maximum cost of \$180,000.

She also stated that the MDOT Certified MBE Utilization and Fair Solicitation Affidavit MBE Attachment D-1A (See Attachment D – MBE Forms in Addendum No. 1) must be submitted with the bid and must identify the specific MBE(s) for this contract. All proposed MBE firms must be certified by the Maryland Department of Transportation (MDOT) in order to count toward the total 20% MBE participation goal. Bidders were advised to pay close attention to Section 4 – Bid Format. A Bid Bond is not required. John Samoryk gave a summary of the new requirements for MBE participation and online compliance system. All questions must be submitted to Sandra Fox preferably by email at sfox@mdstad.com.



# **CONTRACT COMPLIANCE & REPORTING**

#### For Prime Contractor

Prime contractors receive regular reporting notices by email. Simply click the link provided to log in, and enter payments made to the list of subcontractors displayed.

#### For Subcontractors

Once the prime contractor reports their payments, an email notice is sent to each subcontractor.

The subcontractor clicks the link provided to log in, and then confirms the payment reported by the prime has been received.

# **Additional Contractor Benefits**
