Ms. Baker,

Thank you for reaching out to our office recently requesting clarification on State of Maryland Wage Determinations, specifically in regards to the required fringe and the additional a + b requirements. On projects covered by Maryland's Prevailing Wage Law, the a + b representing paid holidays and or vacation is in addition to the required posted fringe amount. The wages paid for those hours are calculated at the employer's shop rate and not the posted prevailing wage rate for the project.
