All Bidders must be registered with eMaryland Marketplace and be in good standing with the State of Maryland in order to receive a contract award. It is the Bidders' responsibility to make sure they have received all appropriate documents prior to the Bid due date.

There is a minimum MBE subcontract participation goal of three percent (3%) of the total dollar value of the contract with no subgoals. The MDOT Certified MBE Utilization and Fair Solicitation Affidavit (MBE Attachment D-1A) is required to be submitted with the Bid and must identify the specific MBE(s) proposed for the contract, along with the services to be performed. A prime MBE contractor may receive credit for self-performing work up to 50% of the total goal (in otherwords 1.5%).


