MSA personnel introduced themselves and Sandra Fox summarized the instructions for submitting Proposals. All Proposals shall be delivered electronically through MSA's third party e-procurement system, Negometrix. All Offerors must be registered with Negometrix in order to submit an offer. Registration is free. Please refer to Attachment J–Video Website for instructions on how to register on the system. This system will not permit proposals to be submitted after the closing date and time so vendors should allow sufficient time to upload and submit documents. Late, faxed, or emailed proposals will not be accepted. It is the Offeror's responsibility to make sure it has received all appropriate documents and addenda prior to the due date.

There is no MBE subcontract participation goal.

Participants on the call were asked to submit an email to Ms. Fox so that an attendance list can be generated and distributed to all interested prime contractors and subcontractors.

Vendors were advised to submit questions in writing to Ms. Fox so that MSA may respond with the information to all vendors through subsequent addenda. Addenda will be posted to MSA website, eMaryland Marketplace Advantage, and Negometrix.

1. Is there an option for a Cloud Based telephone solution?

No. We have considered a cloud-based, solution, but the stadium's infrastructure does not lend itself to that solution. Significant additional dedicated infrastructure would need to be added to support this solution.

4. REFERENCE: Page 9, Item 2.03

In page 9, item 2.03, it states attachment L can be supplied at time of execution of contract. Please confirm if bidders are required to submit this Attachment L with our initial proposal submission on 2/25/2021.

Attachment L (Contract Affidavit) is not required to be submitted with the proposal.

5. **REFERENCE – Page 13, Item 4.01.5**

Page 13, item 4.01.5, NEC ESPP extended system protection plan is purchased at time of upgrade and cannot be offered as (2) additional one-year extensions. Please confirm that the Maryland Stadium Authority will accept NEC Software Assurance (SWA) as two (2) additional one-year extensions.

New Section 4 has been updated to more closely correspond to the extended warranty and software maintenance agreements packages offered by the manufacturer. Please reference Section 4.01.4 and 4.01.5, and 4.03.10 and 4.03.11.
