1.	To accurately fill out the financial proposal form, we wanted to make sure that we understand the MSA's expectations to do so without any budget for the preliminary design services or preliminary cost of construction. Our strategy is to use a market value cost/sf for this building type to develop a budget and create a financial proposal based upon that. We wanted to touch base and make sure that was a reasonable approach for this RFP so that we are providing a competitive proposal.	The approach seems reasonable provided the Offeror meets the requirements outlined in the RFP's Preliminary Design Scope of Work, Section 3.1.
