This addendum is hereby made part of the Request for Proposals dated July9, 2024, on the subject work as though originally included therein. The following amendments, additions, and/or corrections shall govern this solicitation.

This addendum incorporates the following items:

- 1. The Key Information Summary ("KISS") was amended to state corrected contact information for the Procurement. Please note the E-mail address: ckramer@mdstad.com.
- 2. Multiple sections of the RFP were amended to reflect changes to the Site-Visits. Please note that with this addendum NO Site-Visits will be held.
 - a. The line of the KISS announcing the Site-Visits to take place in Calendar Week of July 29 August 2, 2024 was stricken;
 - b. Section 1.9 of the RFP was amended to read: "There will be no Site-Visits."
 - c. Section 3.2 of the RFP was amended to read:

"[...] TOC has identified up to three (3) sites within 10 miles of the Town of Ocean City as the potential location for the Indoor Outdoor Sports Complex.

Site #1 is located adjacent to Stephen Decatur High School and near the intersection of Route 50 and 113 in Berlin, Maryland, as identified in Attachment C.2. Site #2 and Site #3 are not determined at this time."

d. Section 3.3 of the RFP was amended to read:

"The A/E selected through this procurement will work closely with the Project Team to provide the preliminary design necessary to move toward Project design and ultimately, construction of the Project, as described in Attachment C of the RFP.

Preliminary design and engineering services for each Project Component include, but are not limited to, the following, as applicable: [...]"

3. Section 4.1.6 of the RFP was amended to read:

"The Offeror deemed by the Selection Committee to provide the most advantageous Proposal (technical and financial) to the Project will be recommended for award.

Within ten (10) business days from notification that it is the recommended awardee or from the date of the actual award, whichever is earlier, the Offeror must provide the following documentation to the Procurement Officer:

- a. Outreach Efforts Compliance Statement (Attachment D-2);
- b. MBE Subcontractor/Prime Project Participation Certification (Attachment D 3A/3B);
- c. Request for Taxpayer Identification Number and Certification (Form W 9) for the apparent awardee and each subcontractor;
- d. Certificate of Insurance;
- e. MBE Compliance Form; and
- f. A copy of each sub-contract agreement, between the apparent awardee and any proposed MBE sub-contractor that the parties intend to enter into contingent upon the MSA's award of the prime contract. The sub-contract agreement must contain all necessary terms, including pricing, required for the MBE to perform its proposed work and for the apparent awardee to pay the MBE for its work during the term of the agreement."

SCOPE OF SERVICES

The Town of Ocean City has engaged MSA to provide support related to the potential development of an Indoor / Outdoor Sports Complex, as described in the RFP. Through this solicitation, MSA is seeking a highly qualified A/E to provide Preliminary Design Services as described in Section 3 of this Request for Proposals. During this phase of the Project, the A/E will work closely with MSA and other Project Team Members in the analysis of the overall viability of the Project.

The town of Ocean City has identified up to three (3) sites within 10 miles as the potential location for the Project.

Refer to Section 3 of the RFP for the full scope of work and all references to attachments relevant to this RFP.

OFFEROR QUALIFICATIONS

- Has been in business for at least five years;
- Has a team of registered professional architects, engineers, and associated professional consulting firms led by a firm registered to practice in the State of Maryland;
- Has experience providing design services for Government and/or commercial clients;
- Has substantial experience with community involvement during the planning and design phases of a project;
- Has experience in innovative design methods to meet programmatic goals of building efficiencies, on-time delivery, cost containment, and value engineering strategies;
- Has design experience related to the construction of athletic facilities at the collegiate level or above; and
- Has the ability to meet the insurance coverage requirements outlined in the RFP.

MINORITY BUSINESS ENTERPRISES
