2. Enter Stadium through the Southeast Entrance and go through Security.
3. This is an active work site; therefore, ALL Attendees **MUST** wear PPE. This includes hard hats, boots, vests, gloves, and protective eye wear.
4. Gilbane will meet all bidders on the Main Concourse level next to the entrance, just past security.

All additional information will be provided to invited/pre-qualified trade contractors via Bid Supplement through SmartBid.

This project has an overall MBE subcontract participation goal of 35% overall with subgoals of 8% African American and 11% Woman Owned businesses. MBEs must be certified by the Maryland Department of Transportation (MDOT) in order to count towards the goal. No other MBE certifications are acceptable. This project includes prevailing wages. **MBE forms, provided in the SmartBid Plan Room, must be completed, and submitted with all bid proposals.**

Bids are due on November 8, 2024, by no later than 2:00pm. **Late bids will NOT be accepted.
