Northwood Elementary School - Phase 1 - Guaranteed Maximum Price Presentation by Mr. Johnson

Mr. Johnson recommended a Phase 1 Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) contract for \$27,840,394.26 with James G. Davis Construction Inc. (the CM) to replace Northwood Elementary School. The package includes general_requirements, labor, site work, demolition/abatement, utilities, concrete, steel, mechanical, electrical, doors/hardware, and elevator packages as outlined in the CM's GMP submission. MSA's Board approved the CM's preconstruction contract in April 2019, which identified that MSA intended to return with a recommendation to award construction services if pre-construction performance is satisfactory and an acceptable GMP is negotiated. The overall MBE

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participation goal for the project has been set at 30%, and the MBE participation for this early package represents a 30% commitment.

The CM solicited 273 firms and received 56 bids for the 16 bid packages advertised.

Mr. Johnson recommended an amendment to the MCN Build/Southway Builders LLC (the CM") Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) contract for \$17,917,118.00 related to the renovation of Robert Coleman Elementary School. The GMP #2 package includes the remaining trade packages for the comprehensive renovation as outlined in the CM's GMP submission. The overall MBE participation goal for the project has been set at 30%, and the MBE participation for the combined GMPs meet the goals established for the project.

MSA's Board approved the CM's GMP #1 package in March 2020. The CM solicited 365 bidders and received 71 bids for the 23 bid packages advertised.
