- No outages are scheduled for this month.

General Construction Items, 9/1 – 9/30/22

- Construction start is scheduled to begin following Maryland Stadium Authority (MSA) & Maryland Board of Public Works (BPW) authorization. Initial GMP-1 construction activities are planned to start 9/1/2022 including site survey, temporary fencing, cut/cap/make safe of existing utilities, abatement and demolition
- A portion of the Hagerstown Cultural Trail shall be temporarily closed starting 9/6/2022. Closure location occurs from West Baltimore Street to the Herald Mail building adjacent to East Antietam Street. The Trail will be relocated and re-opened at the completion of the project.
- Hood Street shall be permanently closed effective 9/6/2022.
- Demolition of existing buildings is scheduled to complete in Fall 2022. There may be temporary closures of public sidewalks coordinated through the City of Hagerstown to ensure public safety throughout the demolition effort
- Removal and storage of existing lighting, structures and artwork for the Hagerstown Cultural Trail has been coordinated directly through the City of Hagerstown
- GMP-2 Sitework & Structural Bid Packages are out for pricing now

- No work has been scheduled for the foreseeable future. *Subject to change as construction activities progress during the month.*
