## General Construction Items, 1/1 – 1/31/23

- Project status: Active Construction Site
- Heavy Site Demolition remains ongoing. Please be aware of elevated noise levels and construction vehicular traffic during this period.
- Maryland Board of Public Works approved GMP-2 Sitework & Structural Trade Packages. Thus, associated sitework, utilities and structural construction activities will commence this month. Immediate operation entails mass excavation work throughout project site and close to W. Baltimore Street.
- Temporary power work to support construction activities will be upcoming along Summit Ave. Project team continues to coordinate with local power provider.
- Sheeting and shoring along Summit Ave will be upcoming to support demolishment of former Hood Street.
- No upcoming road closures associated with project.
