General Construction Items, 7/1 - 7/31/23

- Project status: Active Construction Site
- GMP Submission Updates:
 - GMP-5 approved by MSA and BPW for several contract awards (i.e., masonry, misc. metals, playing field equipment, glass & glazing etc.)
 - GMP-6 to include contracts for remaining trades excluding food service. GMP-7 will be catered to food service.
- Current Construction Activities:
 - Rock removal underway for building foundations.
 - Stormwater pipe and structure installation near stadium's parking lot and team store commenced. Additional sanitary & water wet utility installation is underway which will require closing W.
 Baltimore for public utility connections. All road closures shall be coordinated through City.
 - Eleven (11) underground storage tanks discovered in the Northwestern corner of project site were successfully removed.
 - Structural concrete activities continue at main building, which includes pouring mud mat/lean concrete for controlled-modulus columns (CMCs) as well as concrete footings and foundation walls.
 - Site grading at stadium's casual entertainment bar is underway.
 - Continued operation of exporting soils to off-site facilities with MDE's authorization.
 - Denver-Elek commenced layout of underground plumbing utilities.
 - Water meter vault set in place.
- Upcoming Construction Activities:
 - Dry Utility Contractor installing primary and secondary electrical service pathways.
 - Ongoing material deliveries: Piping, Rebar, Cast-In-Place & Nyoplast utility structures, Concrete, and Trade Partner Office Trailers.
