General Construction Items 8/1/22-8/31/22

- Construction Ongoing.
- Anticipated Normal Construction Hours August 1st — August 31st: 7:00 AM - 4:30 PM.



Notices

- Abatement of building is ongoing.
- Construction fencing has been installed. Please do not travel through construction area and follow posted signs for detours.
- There will be an increase in traffic from construction vehicles for deliveries and debris removal moving forward.
- Heavy demolition is anticipated to begin on or around 8/12/22. Please prepare for elevated noise levels from this activity.
- The temporary ADA ramp at Bladen Street and College Ave has been installed and is open for public use. This ramp will be removed at the completion of the project and the original ramp will be reopened.
- The temporary pedestrian walkway has been completed and is open to the public at the corner of College Ave. and Bladen Street in anticipation for the upcoming Tunnel Excavation at College Ave. This walkway is connected to the ADA ramp referenced above.
- BGE gas removal has been completed.
- There will be an upcoming electrical outage that will effect the House of Delegates and Legislative Services building that is scheduled for 8/5/12, and 8/12/12. Residential Neighbors will not be impacted by this operation.
- Protection installation has been installed on 2 of the 3 statues at Lawyers Mall in anticipation of demolition activities. The remaining statue will be protected in coordination with the Department of General Services ongoing work on the colonnade.
- Pile installation at the College Ave tunnel is underway. This activity marks the start of heavy machinery use onsite with the mobilization of the drill rig and excavating equipment.
