Project Overview:

The Maryland Stadium Authority is leading a comprehensive redevelopment of the Pimlico Race Course to transform it into a year-round, world-class racing and community destination.

In partnership with McKissack & McKissack and THG Companies, Clark Construction is leading construction management services. Design by Ayers Saint Gross, Populous Holdings, and RK&K.

Upcoming Construction Activities

- Preventative pest control measures are ongoing and will continue throughout construction.
- Groundwater dewatering for the new tunnel will continue with no impact to domestic water utilities. Adjacent property owners were notified per MDE permitting requirements.
- Utility infrastructure installation and related sitework will continue through Summer.
- Concrete foundation and retaining walls will continue through the Spring.
- Steel erection and masonry has begun for the backstretch buildings.

Anticipated Outages & Impacts

- There are no anticipated outages and impacts at this time.
